Remote learning is a method of receiving academic instruction in courses in which the pupil is registered and the courses are taken through a digital learning environment, in this case K-2 ClassTag and 3-12 Google Classroom. Remote learning includes, but is not limited to, online learning and computer-based learning, where the delivery of instruction may incorporate a combination of software, technology, and the Internet. There will be times the teachers interact directly with students and other times recorded lessons and materials will be available. It is expected that students log into their Google Classroom each week day of regularly scheduled school days. The teachers of these courses are Marshall Academy teachers. Grades from Google Classroom in 6-12 will transfer to Skyward and the gradebook. Incomplete work will be marked as a zero when past the deadline. Grades K-5 will be standards based for the 20-21 year. In order for students to move onto their next grade level in 21-22, they must show evidence of mastery of the grade level standards. Incomplete courses in 6-12 will result in loss of credit or inability to progress to the next grade level year in 21-22.

I understand my student will be enrolled in Google Classrooms (3-12) or ClassTag (K-2) and receive remote instruction should the region move to Phase 1-3 and schools must close for in-person instruction, or if the district has to close from guidance by the health department, or when a class has to quarantine. I also understand I cannot move my student to the Edgenuity platform if schools move into Phase 1-3 and go to the virtual option. If I choose to have my student do in-person instruction, they will complete the course remotely if in Phase 1-3.

The school will work with families to provide needed technology (chromebooks) if the home does not have a compatible device (home computer, laptop, or smartphone).
