Virtual learning is a method of receiving academic instruction in courses in which the pupil is registered and the courses are taken through a digital learning environment, in this case Edgenuity. The virtual only option will be offered through this platform for the 20-21 school year. Virtual learning includes, but is not limited to, online learning and computer-based learning, where the delivery of instruction may incorporate a combination of software, technology, and the Internet. The teachers of these courses are not Marshall Academy teachers.
